Subject: Fees for POST Profiles

ATTN: Department heads, agency background investigators, personnel staff, and private background investigators

Effective December 1, 2006, POST will charge for providing POST profiles to/for individuals **not** currently employed by a POST participating department. There are additional fees for requests to expedite the process and/or notarize the document.

POST will continue to provide current peace officers and dispatchers employed by participating departments with free profile copies.

When fees are applicable, the individual who makes a request for his or her profile must attach the proper (fees) to the request. When a department is making a request for an individual's background package and the individual is not currently a peace officer, the department is responsible for including the fee with the request.
