Case Overview*

Provide a detailed description of the case, including background information and significance of the case (3 page maximum).

Supporting Documentation

Attach any materials relevant to the case, such as newspaper articles, media clips, photographs, letters of recommendation, etc. Please provide copies — original documents will not be returned.

*Required documentation

Nomination Requirements & Application Submission Details

- Award nomination must be submitted within one year following case adjudication.
- Case nominations that have not been adjudicated require a written statement from the department head to verify that the District Attorney's Office has approved a public presentation of the case.
- All sections of the application must be completed, and each nomination requires department head approval/signature.
- Attach justification and supporting documentation to application.

*Nominations must be postmarked or received no later than **January 17, 2014***

*Awards will be presented at the Detective Symposium on **April 9, 2014***
